

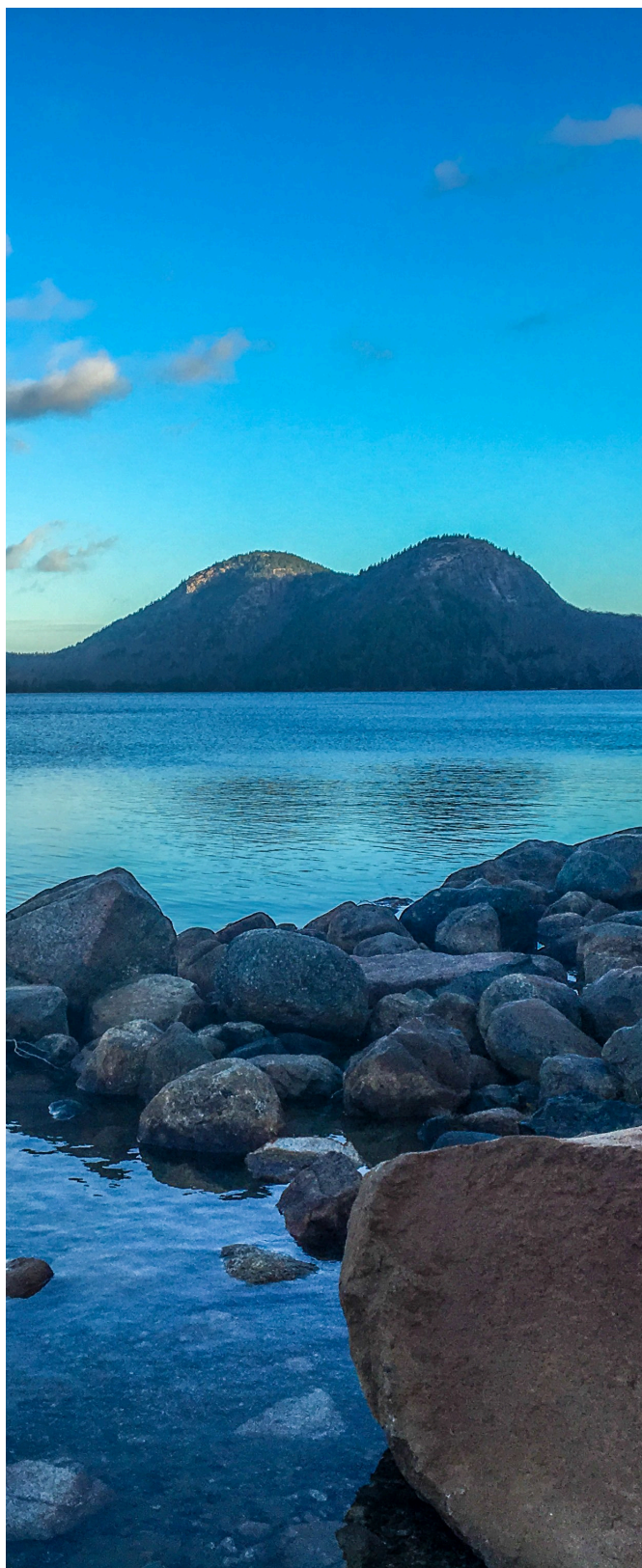


# Dawnland Jordan Pond House

Dawnland operates the historic Jordan Pond House Restaurant, a tradition that began in the 1890's serving iconic popovers on the lawn overlooking idyllic Jordan Pond. We also operate three retail gift shops, which are located in some of the most beautiful spots in Acadia National Park, Cadillac Mountain, Thunder Hole and Jordan Pond.







## Job Descriptions

**Busser, Host, and Barista: \$10.50/hr. +tips**

**Public Area Attendant: \$15.00/hr.**

**Guest Services: \$14.00/hr.**

**Dishwasher: \$15.00/hr.**

**Cook, Prep Cook, Deli: \$16.00/hr.**

**Cashier: \$14.00/hr.**

The tipped positions are paid their tips bi-weekly on their regular paycheck. We offer a seasonal bonus for participants who complete their offer letter contract date. Employees earn \$1.00 for every regular hour worked throughout their season if they stay until the date listed on their offer letter. The bonus is \$1.00 for every regular hour the employee has worked throughout their contract.

## Work Hours

35–40 hours per week, with overtime available during peak season of July and August.

## Uniform

Participants must bring khaki pants and/or shorts (please no cargo pants or shorts). Shorts should be knee length. Participants will need to bring black, non-slip shoes. We provide two polo shirts, a fleece jacket, and a baseball cap (optional to wear a hat).

## Housing Information

Housing and meals are provided for approximately \$110 per week. You will be living in a dormitory within walking distance of the restaurant. You will be living in a rustic setting, 4 people per bunk room. You will share a dorm style bathroom with all the students on your floor (same gender). You are required to keep your living space clean according to National Park standards; rooms are inspected weekly. Men and women live on separate floors. There is no "couples" housing.

Meals (cooked by the dorm cook) are included. There are no cooking facilities in dorm rooms.

Rent also includes free laundry and detergent, shampoo, conditioner, soap, and lotion. Linens and towels are available by request. T

he dorm is located in Acadia National Park, about 8 miles from the town of Bar Harbor, Maine.

Yes, there is a \$125.00 security deposit that is deducted from the employees' first two paychecks (\$62.50 each paycheck). It is fully refundable as long as the unit is left in satisfactory condition.



## Area Description

Acadia National Park is located on Mount Desert Island, Maine, United States. It was the first National Park established, east of the Mississippi River. It boasts 26 mountains (with the tallest being Cadillac Mountain), miles of rocky coast and two dozen ponds and lakes. We are close to Bar Harbor, Maine, which provides restaurants, shopping, and on the water excursion tours. Participants will have the opportunity to sign up for Dawnland sponsored trips including but not limited to, kayaking, biking, shopping trips, karaoke nights etc. There is local theatre, food festivals, garden tours, and MUCH more to experience in the participants' off time.
